A. CONSENT CALENDAR:

1. MOTION by Member Lubs, SECONDED by Member Motta, approving Regular Subcommittee meeting minutes of July 24, 2025, MOTION PASSED. 3/0. *Member Giroux abstained as he did not attend the meeting.*

B. NEW BUSINESS

2. PW (25-05) Repair of Distressed Walls and Surfaces at Recreation Park

Recreation Manager Palmer led the discussion on the Public Works Project (25-05) Repair of Distressed Walls and Surfaces at Recreation Park. Member Lubs inquired whether court repairs were included in the project scope and whether contingency funds were included in the bid. He also recommended the development of a long-term maintenance plan. Member Motta asked if Stevenson Field was included in the project and requested clarification on the anticipated timeline. Member Giroux questioned how future damage could be prevented if the project is approved by the City Council at the October 7 meeting and emphasized the importance of maintenance to avoid recurring costs. Member Pickhaver asked if there were any opportunities to reduce the overall project cost. Director of Public Works Elias Sassoon and Senior Civil Engineer Cheryl Ebert provided additional information.

C. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

3. Teen Center, Teen Plaza, and Skatepark Update

Recreation Manager Palmer provided an update on the Teen Center, Teen Plaza, and Skatepark project. Member Lubs asked whether the seat wall on the

east side of the basketball court would be removed. Member Giroux inquired whether the seat wall was a cosmetic decision and suggested that adding padding could be a beneficial improvement. Member Motta raised questions regarding alternate paint options and the cost of ongoing maintenance. Director of Public Works Sassoon and Senior Civil Engineer Ebert provided additional information.

D. COMMENTS – SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS

Member Giroux inquired about the usage and revenue generation of pickleball, tennis, and paddle courts, and whether the associated report had been reviewed by the Recreation and Parks Department. He requested that the report be placed on the next Recreation and Parks Commission agenda for further discussion, specifically to determine whether converting a tennis court to pickleball courts should be considered or if the existing configuration should remain.

Member Motta inquired about the status of the Recreation Field Regulation report and whether any action is currently being taken.

Member Lubs reported that the pole at the Little League field is damaged and asked if repairs are being considered. He also expressed his appreciation to the staff for their hard work.
